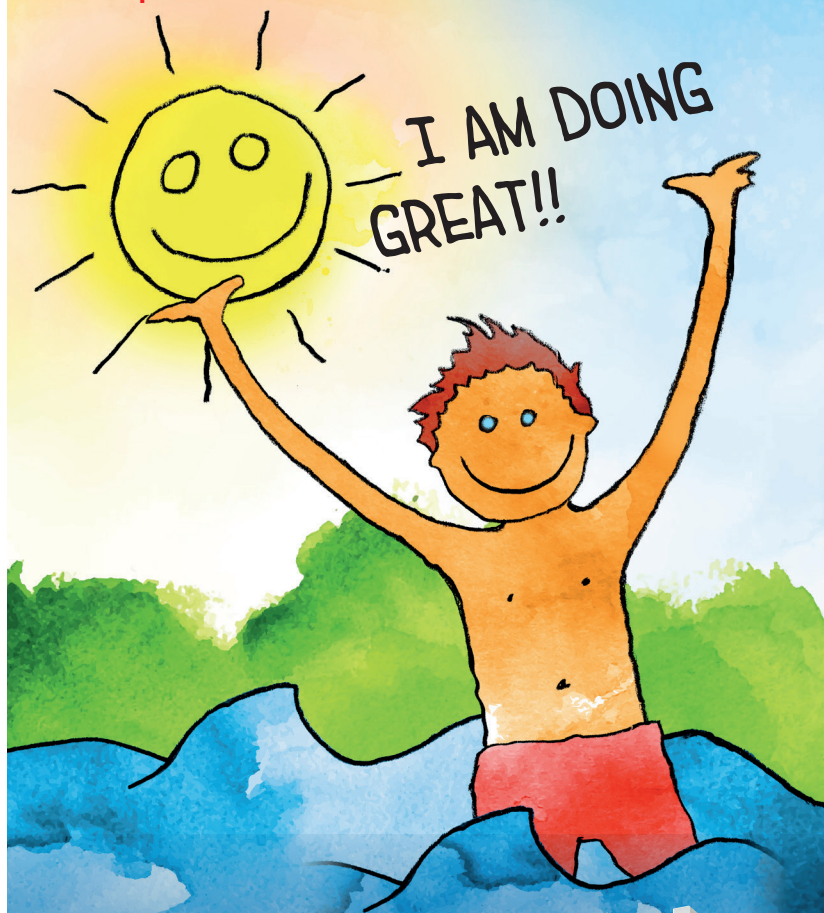

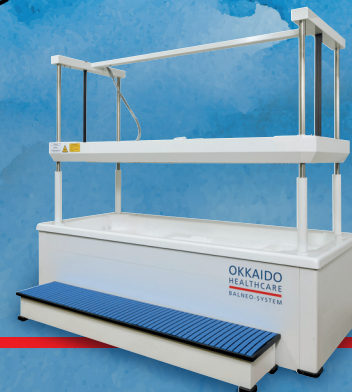

Procedure for synchronous photosol therapy (combined brine/UV-B light treatment)

- Examination and prescription by your dermatologist.
- Scheduling an appointment
Important: Every treatment appointment is a binding agreement and can only be canceled 24 hours in advance.
- Please arrive 15 min. prior to your appointment
- Sign-in at the front desk

- After the therapy, dry-up, change and please schedule / confirm your next therapy appointment.

- Bathing slippers
- Towel

The Synchronous Photosol Therapy (bath in brine with simultaneous UV-B-light radiation therapy without plastic foils)

is a recognised therapy for the treatment of psoriasis and neurodermatitis.

Patients suffering from moderate to severe dandruff and neurodermatitis are entitled to photosol therapy as a statutory health insurance benefit.

Synchronous Photosol Therapy combines a brine bath (original Dead Sea salt) in a specially shaped therapy pool with simultaneous UV-B light irradiation. This form of photosol therapy can be prescribed by a registered dermatologist for the treatment of psoriasis and neurodermatitis.

A treatment cycle comprises a maximum of 35 applications. Three to five applications should be carried out per week. The costs of these treatments are covered by health insurance companies. After a break of six months, a new treatment cycle of 35 applications can be carried out if required.
